

Command Line Arguments

Command Line Arguments

- Similar (yet different) to C/C++
- in C/C++:
 - argv[] contains prog. name and arguments
 - argc contains number of arguments plus one
- in Perl:
 - @ARGV contains list of arguments
 - \$0 contains program name

Examples:

- `myscript 15 4 hello`
 - @ARGV → (15, 4, "hello")
 - \$0 → "myscript"
 - scalar(@ARGV) → 3
- `perl_hw2`
 - @ARGV → ()
 - \$0 → "perl_hw2"
 - scalar(@ARGV) → 0
